Activities

Are there any disagreements between historians about their discoveries? If you had lived long ago, would you have been an explorer? Why or why not? Pretend to be one or the other and make preparations for a great voyage of discovery. What do you need to do? Take? Know? Keep a diary about the whole adventure. When you have found some new land, give it a name and build a settlement on it. Live there for awhile. Are there any difficulties? Do you feel homesick? What do you think God might want you to do when you grow up?
